School Board Meeting

During the past Board meeting, the Board held it's annual reorganization meeting during which Eileen Travis was elected president and Kim Christofferson was elected clerk. The Board also approved their meeting schedule for the 2020 school year. As in previous years, the Board generally holds their monthly meetings on the third Tuesday of each month. The Board also approved revisions to district policies; approved the 2nd Interim Budget report, and discussed protocols/procedures for handling threats, and approved the Accounting of Developer Fees reports.

Items on the next meeting's agenda (January 21) include approval of our School Safety Plan, review of the annual School Accountability Report Card (SARC), and approval of the 2018/2019 audit of our prior year budget.

PARKING  **LOT SAFETY**

Please do not leave your vehicle unattended when it is stopped in the student pick up/drop off queue in the parking lot.

Unattended vehicles cause parent frustration and numerous lane changes, which in turn, negatively affect safety.

Parking is available along the west fence line near the solar panels/gym area.

The street curb adjacent to the school office is marked **RED.**

Red indicates NO STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING whether the vehicle is attended or unattended. Drivers exiting the parking lot cannot get a clear view of oncoming traffic if vehicles are parked along the red curb.

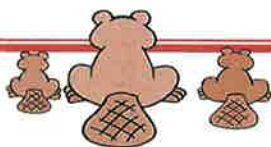
DON'T MISS OUT!

Goin' places? Don't forget to pack your Independent Study Contract! The use of an Independent Study Contract is one way to receive attendance credit while not actually being present in the classroom. Funding for the school that would otherwise be lost is also recovered. Independent Study is available for students who will be absent for more than 3-5 days. Requests for Independent Study must be made at least three (3) days in advance for teachers to prepare assignments. The teacher and administrator must agree to the request.

Students completing all Independent Study assignment will receive credit and will not be marked as absent. For more information, please check with the office.
